### Grand Marnier at Courtyard at 51

Rather quirkily hidden down a cobbled mews off Buckingham Gate, Courtyard at 51 has opened its leafy alfresco space – complete with cherubs in a central fountain (said to be gifted by Queen Victoria no less) – for its second summer season.

Grand Marnier has teamed up with the venue to offer six fruit cups that offer an alternative tittle for Pimm's o'clock; the Grand Esprit contains Grand Marnier, elderflower cordial, soda and fresh fruit, and the other five – Grand Tonic, Grand Rouge, Grand Ginger, Grand Mojito, all priced at £6.75 – offer similarly summery, fresh and fruity mixes.

Beyond serving Grand Marnier in its many guises, the courtyard – which is surrounded by the five star townhouse hotel, 51 Buckingham Gate, Taj Suites and Residences – will be hosting a series of weekly Friday grills inspired by the adjoining Michelin-starred Quilon, with Southern Coastal Indian dishes being served a la carte. (Other nights in the Courtyard at 51 will follow an Arabian/Lebanese/Moroccan theme.)

This year a new raised dining veranda has been added to the historic setting, offering an even better view of the Shakespearean frieze that sweeps along the terracotta façades of the townhouses surrounding the garden.
